SHROVE TUESDAY: *shrove* past tense of the English verb *shrive*, to obtain absolution. Shrove Tuesday gets its name from the custom for Christians to be "shriven" before the start of Lent. Pancakes, Fat Tuesday, Mardis Gras, are feasts to use up the fat, butter and rich foods before Lent.
