Through the years Holy Trinity has focused on Christian worship and service, reaching out to meet the needs of the world both near and far, from supporting our local food bank to welcoming community groups to use our facilities, making mission trips to Nicaragua and sending supplies to the North. Worship has ranged from very traditional to quite revolutionary, including radio broadcasts of praise and prayer.

And now we come to a new stage in our life together as we enter into the Growing In Faith Together (GIFT) financial stewardship campaign to enrich the ministry both of Holy Trinity and of our Diocese of Ottawa. This is an opportunity to envision how we can do much more; how we can follow Jesus into new ministries, becoming a greater blessing to those around us.

We are privileged to be a living Member of a larger body, the Diocese of Ottawa. Our Diocese provides many resources: training and courses for laypeople and clergy; assistance for struggling congregations; practical help for vulnerable children; and the operation of community social services such as Centre 454, Cornerstone, and The Well. Through GIFT we will contribute significantly to these Diocesan ministries, as well as to those in the North and further afield. Our parish of Holy Trinity has benefitted greatly from financial grants provided by the Diocese over the past three years as well.

Our goal is to raise \$235,000, \$97,500 of which will go to support ministries in the Diocese and beyond with the remaining \$137,500 being retained for our purposes. Our need to raise this money is clear – we need to fix our church and we need to continue our work sharing God’s unconditional grace and love, all with your generous support.

Each of us is called to respond faithfully to the needs of our church and of our community. Your participation in the campaign, by making a sacrificial, meaningful and proportionate gift over a five-year pledge period, is gratefully appreciated.
